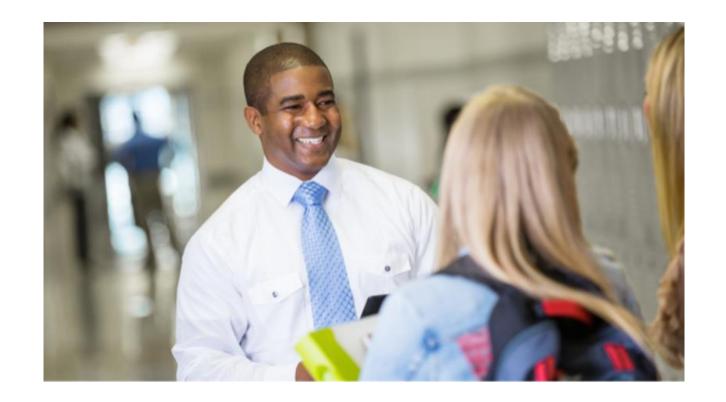

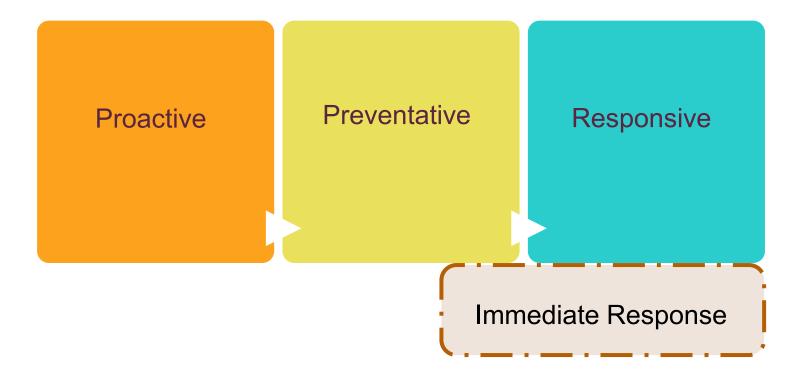

What You Can Do – Proactive

Create safe predictable environments

- Develop connection and belonging
- Employ social-emotional skills



What You Can Do – Preventative

 Teach and recognize warning signs

 Monitor systems and outcomes

Early identification

- Tiered Response (Interventions)
- Progress monitoring

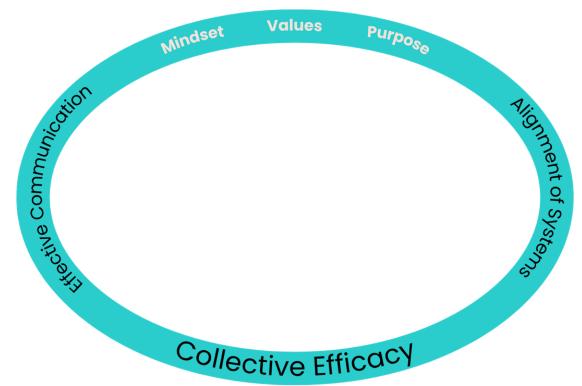

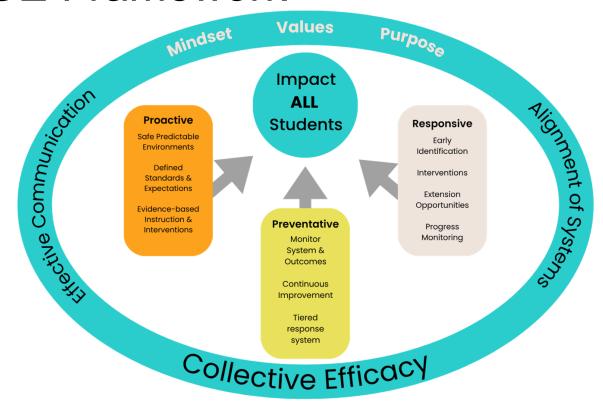
