

SAFER Cyber 6 Requirements

Member Requirements Set By SAFER Board of Directors

SAFER members are required to adhere to six (6) standard cybersecurity controls as part of their information security program. These controls are generally accepted in the industry as mandatory basic hygiene to help defend against an evolving threat landscape. It's important to note that these controls should be considered foundational elements, but not an exhaustive list of best practices. Organizations operating a mature cybersecurity posture utilize a layered, defense-in-depth approach to mitigate their cybersecurity risk.

SAFER Cyber 6 Controls

	Multifactor Authentication	MFA enforced for all staff across critical applications, email and remote access.
	Firewalls and Antivirus	Next generation firewall (NGFW) protection on all internet-facing connections and next generation antivirus (NGAV) on all clients and servers.
δ _Φ	Security Awareness Training	Annual cybersecurity awareness training for all staff and ideally, employee cyber resilience training for key staff capable of catastrophic change.
3.0	Endpoint Detection and Response	Leading Endpoint Detection & Response (EDR) platform implemented across all clients and servers.
	Immutable Backups	Data backups following 3-2-1 architecture accessed via off-domain credentials, ideally with MFA. Backups should be both immutable and deletion resistant.
	Vulnerability Scanning	Regular internal and external vulnerability scans across all network environments.
